




ITINERARY

Day 1: Arrival in St. Petersburg



- Arrive at St. Petersburg International Airport by any convenient flight
- Meet & greet on arrival by our local representative
- Transfer to the hotel
- Hotel check-in: 02:00 PM
- Free time to relax and freshen up
- Evening scenic cruise on the Neva River
- Enjoy stunning views of illuminated city landmarks
- Dinner at an Indian restaurant
- Overnight stay at the hotel in St. Petersburg





Day 2: Explore St. Petersburg

- Discover Russia's imperial capital, renowned for its grand avenues, canals, and world-class architecture
- A city where art, history, and elegance come together



- **Hermitage Museum**

One of the world's largest and most prestigious art museums, showcasing centuries of global art and history

- **Church of the Savior on Spilled Blood**

Iconic Russian architecture with colorful onion domes and intricate mosaics

- **St. Isaac's Cathedral**

Architectural marvel with a massive golden dome and panoramic city views from the colonnade

- **Kazan Cathedral**

Grand neoclassical cathedral inspired by St. Peter's Basilica, located on Nevsky Prospekt


Day 3: Explore Remaining City of St. Petersburg

- Peter and Paul Fortress – the historic heart of the city
- Drive past / walk along Nevsky Prospekt, the city's most famous boulevard
- View the city's beautiful canals, bridges, and historic squares
- Free time for shopping or leisure exploration
- Dinner at an Indian / local restaurant
- Overnight stay at the hotel in St. Petersburg

Day 4: St. Petersburg → Murmansk by Railway

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner



- Breakfast at the hotel
- Transfer to Ladozhsky Railway Station
- Board a comfortable long-distance sleeper train operated by Russian Railways
- Scenic railway journey covering approximately 1,400 km
- Travel time: 24–28 hours
- Route passes through the picturesque region of Karelia, featuring dense forests, rivers, and remote northern settlements
- Gradual transition from imperial landscapes to Arctic terrain
- Lunch and dinner served during the journey (as per arrangement)
- Arrival at Murmansk Railway Station, one of the northernmost passenger rail routes in the world
- Especially enchanting in winter during polar night conditions



Day 5: Arrival in Murmansk

- **Orientation city tour of Murmansk**

Day 6: Explore Murmansk & Teriberka

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

- **Visit the famous Old Ships Graveyard, showcasing abandoned fishing vessels**
- **Explore Dragon Egg Beach, known for its unique round stone formations**
- **Visit Sandy Beach and the scenic Arctic Waterfall**
- **Lunch at a local restaurant in Teriberka**
- **Evening return to Murmansk**
- **Evening excursion for Aurora Hunting (if not experienced on the previous night; subject to weather conditions)**
- **Dinner at a local restaurant**
- **Overnight stay at the hotel in Murmansk**

Day 7 : Murmansk. (Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)



- Breakfast at the hotel
- Visit to the ethno-park of the Saami people, the oldest indigenous community of Northern Europe
- Experience Saami folklore, traditional tales, and shamanic rituals
- Participate in national games and enjoy feeding reindeer
- Relish a traditional Saami lunch, including herbal tea, berry pie, soup, and a main course
- Transfer to the Husky Park, where sled dogs are professionally trained and cared for
- Meet over 50 Siberian Huskies and other sled dogs
- Learn fascinating stories about sled dog culture and Arctic expeditions
- Tea stop at the farm with a short film screening on dog races
- Late-night excursion for Aurora Lights viewing (if not experienced on previous nights; subject to weather conditions)
- Dinner at a local restaurant
- Return to Murmansk
- Overnight stay at the hotel in Murmansk

Day 8: MURMANSK → ST. PETERSBURG → INDIA

- Early morning check-out from the hotel in Murmansk
- Transfer to Murmansk Airport
- Board the domestic flight to St. Petersburg
- Arrival at St. Petersburg International Airport
- Proceed to board your international flight to India
- End of the tour with unforgettable memories of the Arctic wonders and imperial Russia
